Travelling Reminder in regard to Novel Coronavirus Infection

Due to the development of the Novel Coronavirus Infection, many countries have imposed entry restrictions to Chinese tourists recently. In order to avoid entry hindrance, the Identification Services Bureau (DSI) advises Macao residents who plan to travel abroad to obtain the latest information on immigration and quarantine arrangement of their destination prior to their travel. For detailed information, Macao residents can inquire the embassy or consular missions of the country that they plan to travel to, or they can visit the website of the National Immigration Administration of the People's Republic of China <https://www.nia.gov.cn/n741440/n741542/c1245203/content.html>.
